He played basketball and was 1st baseman on the Castlemont High School baseball team along with legendary player Joe Morgan.

A "jack of all trades," Jim had a variety of jobs over the years, including bartender, salesman, track driver, and an owner of a home improvement business. The "gift

of gab" came easily to Jim and he had a large circle of friends.

Jim enjoyed playing golf all over the United States and was on an adult softball league. He also enjoyed coaching his sons, Steven and Darren, on their Little League baseball teams. Jim married Patty in 1984. In their free time, they enjoyed traveling and playing golf.

Then, in 1998, a stroke left Jim with weakness in his arm and leg as well as aphasia. Without warning, Jim's athleticism and verbal skills dramatically changed.

However, Jim's life did not end

with his stroke. Never one to stay down for long, Jim began attending the Aphasia Center of California in 2000. A born leader, he loved helping others in the groups. And by helping others, Jim saw that he was helping himself as well. Patty adds that the support of friends and family was also invaluable in Jim's recovery.

Since the stroke, Patty and Jim have put traveling back on their schedules. They've taken a cruise to Alaska, spent time in Arizona and Santa Barbara, and visited family
